Dear Friend:

Please read this--and heave a sigh of relief!

This is the end of the Fact-finders. While there are some aspects of the Outline of Conditions not as fully covered as we should like, we have finished the formation and release of FFs and feel we have completed this phase of the Program.

We are aware that in some instances the rapid release of FFs the past few weeks has meant a heavy load on some of you. But we could see no other alternative: If we were to receive the balance of the needed summary statement material it had to be now or never! Several units have closed; others are rapidly reaching a point where early closing will occur.

Though there will be no further FFs, it is more than possible that in some of our special projects--having to do with publicity and public education, for instance--we will need certain specific information. In such circumstances, special questionnaires may be sent to you.

In a certain sense you are entitled to the hearty thanks (and you have it!) of everyone on the MHP staff. But in a wider sense, we aren't in the position to offer gratitude. This is a CPS project. It has developed and shall continue to proceed as such. Those of us here happen to be at the focal point of activity for the present time. If there are thanks, they shall come in the future as a result of the preventive and restorative treatment made possible to patient lives.
